

Squash Tasmania Junior Performance Pathway Committee Chair Regulation

The chairperson for the Squash Tasmania Performance Pathway Committee will be selected by Squash Tasmania and if they accept will have the following additional responsibilities:

- To ensure that the responsibilities of the Committee are met on time e.g. organise quarterly meetings.
- To report to Squash Tasmania the results of each Committee meeting.
- To ensure that Squash Tasmania Performance Pathway players and State Junior Team players are selected in accordance with the Squash Tasmania Performance Pathway Player Selection Regulation and Tasmanian State Junior Team Selection Regulation.
- To ensure that Bookings Managers and Household Managers are selected in accordance with the Tasmanian State Junior Bookings Manager and Household Manager Regulation.
- To manage the Committee's selection of Performance Pathway players and State Junior Team.
- To ensure that the selection of Performance Pathway Squad and State Team is sufficiently documented.
 - Note the date and time of the meeting
 - Note each age group and gender considered
 - Discuss the players as a group relating to the selection criteria
 - Narrow down top players
 - Select players in accordance with the selection criteria and note whether this was a majority decision or not and why each player was included
 - If players were narrowly excluded or included to note why this was so
- Any information collected on individual players is to remain private and confidential between the Committee and Squash Tasmania.
- Details of State Team selection are to be summarised for Squash Tasmania and shall be made public through Squash Tasmania.
- In the event where a player selection majority is not reached, the chairperson is to make the final decision.
- To abide by Squash Tasmania's Member Protection Policy and sign the Member Protection Declaration form and return this to Squash Tasmania.
