

## **Squash Tasmania Code of Conduct**

As a player, manager, coach or other official with the Tasmanian State Junior Team I agree to abide by the following code of conduct:

- Will not take prohibited/illegal drugs.
- Will not drink alcohol if under legal drinking age, or if of legal drinking age will not drink while participating in the Tournament.\*
- Will abide by the rules of the Tournament.
- Will follow all instructions issued by the Household Manager, Coaching Team Leader/Tour Manager and coaching team.
- Will coach, play squash or support players in the spirit of the game with respect for all players and officials.
- Will not bully, tease or put down other members of the Team, or players from other States or Territories.
- Will support all members of the Team by watching each other's matches and assisting with scoring or refereeing as required.
- Will assist the coaches, manager and other officials away at the championships with the cleaning and cooking for the Team if requested by the Household Manager.
- Will remain with the Team group at all times unless express permission to leave the group is given by the Tour Manager/Coaching Team Leader or a person delegated by the Tour Manager.
- Will read and abide by Squash Tasmania's Member Protection Policy.

Note: for managers, coaches, parents and officials this means that while acting in your capacity as a member of the team group which involves a duty of care to the players you will not consume excessive alcohol (will remain under the legal drinking limit). At least one adult is to remain under the legal alcohol limit at all times to ensure a duty of care.

A violation of the code of conduct may result in the person being sent home from the tournament at their own expense.
