

## **Squash Tasmania Junior Performance Pathway Committee Regulation**

The Committee will be selected by Squash Tasmania and will include at least one male and one female member and will include at least one member from the north and one from the south.

Squash Tasmania should aim to select 3 persons for the Committee. To be considered for selection a person must:

- Be registered and of good standing with Squash Tasmania.
- Have a thorough knowledge of junior squash (it would be useful to have experience with the level of interstate competition).
- Be considered to have the ability to act as an impartial selector.

The Committee members must agree to the following conditions:

- To be impartial in their selection of the Performance Pathway Players and Tasmanian State Junior Team.
- To commit to quarterly meetings (January, April, July and October) to review the Performance Pathway players in accordance with the Player Selection Regulation.
- As a part of each meeting to review reports on players from Performance Pathway Coaches and to consider whether there are possible new players requiring an invite to the squad.
- To commit to attend the two state junior team selection tournaments in order to watch the players under consideration for the Tasmanian State Junior Team.
- As part of the October meeting to select the Performance Pathway Junior Household Manager in accordance with the Tasmanian Junior Household Manager Regulation for the Australian Junior Open and Australian Junior Championships.
- As part of the January meeting to select the Tasmanian Junior Team Bookings Manager in accordance with the Tasmanian Junior Team Bookings Manager Regulation for the first Australian tournament held around April each year.
- As part of the January meeting to select the Coaching Team Leader for the Australian Junior Open in accordance with the Coaching Team Leader Selection Regulation.
- As part of the April meeting to receive reports from the Household Manager and Coaching Team Leader on the first Australian junior tournament for the year.
- As part of the April meeting to select the Tasmanian State Junior Bookings Manager in accordance with the Tasmanian Junior Team Bookings Manager Regulation for the Australian Junior Championships.
- As part of the July meeting to select the Tasmanian State Junior Team in accordance with the Tasmanian State Junior Team Selection Regulation.
- As part of the July meeting to select the Coaching Team Leader for the Australian Junior Championships in accordance with the Coaching Team Leader Selection Regulation.
- To ensure Squash Australia receives a copy of the current Tasmanian ranking to assist with seeding of players in the Australian Junior Open and Australian Junior Championships. Up to date rankings should be provided to Squash Australia every three months. In addition, details of any other player performance information which could impact on seeding at major events should be provided.

- As part of the October meeting to select the Performance Pathway Players for the following year in accordance with the Player Selection Regulation and send out invitations to these players.
- As part of the October meeting to receive reports from the State Junior Household Manager and State Junior Team Coaching Team Leader on the player results and conduct at the Australian Junior Championships.
- To conduct meetings with the Household Manager and Coaching Team Leader prior to submitting reports to Squash Tasmania on the Australian Junior Open and Australian Junior Championships.
- The committee must document their selection process, player performances and program performance and report to Squash Tasmania.
- Provide substantial input into the ongoing maintenance and update of the Performance Pathway documentation.
- To abide by Squash Tasmania's Member Protection Policy and sign the Member Protection Declaration form and return this to Squash Tasmania.
- To commit to attend the two annual Performance Pathway group training sessions and to attend the State Team group training session.
- To maintain a list of Performance Pathway Coaches and consider applications.

Of the selected Performance Pathway Committee members, Squash Tasmania must also nominate a Committee Chairperson who will have the additional responsibilities in accordance with the Squash Tasmania Performance Pathway Committee Chair Regulation.

The Committee is also to monitor the players who may be selected as part of the Tasmanian State Junior Team in accordance with the Tasmanian State Junior Team Selection Regulation so a decision can be made efficiently at the conclusion of the final selection tournament.

Squash Tasmania will call for written nominations at the end of December closing at the end of January that address the criteria for being a Performance Pathway Committee member. Squash Tasmania will then select three persons to form the Performance Pathway Committee for that year who best address the Committee Member criteria prior to the Squash Tasmania AGM.
