

Squash Tasmania State Junior Team Selection Tournament Regulation

Two state team selection tournaments are to be held each year, one in the North West and one in the South.

1. The tournaments shall be open to male and female players who are turning 19 years of age or under in the calendar year of the tournament.
2. Entry forms to compete in the tournament must be forwarded by the Tournament Administrators to all Squash Tasmania affiliated clubs at least one month prior to the closing date for entries to the Tournament.
3. All completed entry forms are required to be returned to the Tournament Administrators by the closing date as nominated by the Tournament Administrators on the entry form. The Tournament Administrators have the discretion to accept late entries.
4. A preliminary draw is to be completed and circulated for comment to all affiliated clubs and coaches.
5. The Tournament Administrators are to be responsible for the draw of each event.
6. Draws are to be completed based on the entrants to the Tournament on a 'graded' rather than an 'Age Group' basis.
7. All draws are to aim to utilise an 8 Player Swiss Draw System. This may be supplemented by an initial play-off game therefore utilising a 16 Player Swiss Draw System.
8. In the event there are insufficient numbers in each division for a Swiss Draw the Tournament Administrators has the discretion to implement a Round Robin format.
9. For novice divisions a Round Robin draw should be utilised.
10. In preparing the draw, the Tournament Administrators will take into account the current State Rankings and recommendations from coaches in the event there are new players.
11. For the Swiss Draw System all players will be placed in the order of their seeding:
 - 1 seed / position 1
 - 2 seed / position 2
 - 3 seed / position 3
 - and so on...
12. All reasonable steps will be taken to avoid drawing first round matches between competitors from the same Club.
13. The Tournament draw is 'final' following the Tournament Administrators consideration and amendment for withdrawals. The draw may be adjusted up to the time of the first match at the discretion of the Tournament Administrator.
14. If any player withdraws from the Tournament prior to the commencement of the tournament, the Tournament Administrators will fill the vacancy by moving the players in accordance with the method originally used to establish the draw.
15. Any match time changes due to religion, study or any other reason is solely at the discretion of the Tournament Administrators and the affected opponent.
16. The winner, runner up and third place in each Event, is to receive a trophy, medallion, prize or certificate.
17. No prize money is to be paid to any competitor.
